Lighting		Nearly Normal	Rising, as with most everything else	Costs are up, mainly due to the increased costs of base material and freight issues.
Lamps & Ballasts		Nearly Normal	Steady	Lead times and availability are mostly back to pre-pandemic levels. Costs are up, as with general lighting.
Wire & Cable		Increasing issues with availability	Volatile	With highs of \$5.00 per # seen recently, the base cost of CU is up. Lead times on once common building wire have begun to rise in recent months.
Voice Data & Video		Nearly Normal	Volatile	Same as the above. The pricing of raw metals has made low voltage cable costs fluctuate. Issues persist with low voltage cable. Some once common types are holding lead times of 2-3 months as of now.
Distribution Equipment		Beyond major issues with availability	Rising Fast	Most major manufacturers are resorting to rationing out goods, as they become available. Distributors are limited to how much they can purchase of certain SKU's. If any at all in some cases. Lead times in some segments (metering) can be up to a year for production dates.
Tools & Equipment		Nearly Normal	Rising, as with most everything else	Availability, in most cases, is back to pre-pandemic levels. Some items made overseas are experiencing increased lead times.
Conduit Raceway		Nearly Normal	Rising, as with most everything else	Costs are up, mainly due to the increased costs of base material and freight issues.
Lighting Controls		Normal	Rising, as with most everything else	Production seems to be mostly back to normal on major components.
Conduit Access		Increasing issues with availability	Rising, as with most everything else	Raw material shortages are pushing lead times even longer than they have been.
Heat & Fans		Nearly Normal	Rising, as with most everything else	Current US supply seems stable. As with anything metal, costs have increased.
Wiring Devices		Increasing issues with availability	Rising, as with most everything else	Costs are up, mainly due to the increased costs of base material. Many common parts, are still hard to source.
Fuses, Signaling, Hardware & Access		Nearly Normal	Rising, as with most everything else	Same as with most everything. Disruption in the supply chain has led to raw material shortages, and that now leads to less product availability.
Safety Products		Nearly Normal	Rising, as with most everything else	Items made with resin or plastic are getting harder to source as both materials have been in short supply.
PVC		Beyond major issues with availability	Rising, as with most everything else	This has been ongoing for over a year now. Raw material issues, and production delays, are pushing lead times out for 3-4 months on some parts.
